
Computer Museum of America is a great place for school field trips whether you have a class of 10 or a team of 120! We are in nearby Roswell with easy access from GA 400 and there's plenty of free parking for school or charter buses.

Our exhibits cover a variety of Georgia Standards of Excellence (GSE) in Math, Science, Social Studies, and of course, Computer Science. There are also many opportunities to explore Art, Design, and Language Arts.

Tour your way at CMoA! We have two options for your field trip:

1. **Digital self-guided tours** (1.5 - 2.0 hours) - our very popular new addition.
 - a. Students use clues to find artifacts, answer questions, and complete missions via an app on either their own phones or our iPads.
 - b. Students work in teams of no more than four students with only one device needed.
 - c. The questions are geared toward your grade level GSE and give the students background information about the artifacts as well as guiding them throughout the entire museum.
 - d. Activity and 'mission' questions give students a chance for a little fun via selfies, video creation, and competitions within their team or against their classmates.
 - e. After all the students finish, a report is available for you, the teacher, to review showing you how they answered the questions and giving you access to all the media they created.
 - f. Volunteers and staff are on hand to talk to the students and assist them with the app.
 - g. A classroom lesson/activity can be added to your visit for a small additional charge.
2. **Traditional guided tours** (2 - 2.5 hours).
 - a. Your classes will take a tour via rotations to different stations throughout the museum.
 - b. Staff or volunteers will meet your students at each location and provide highlighted information about the artifacts.
 - c. One rotation includes one of our classroom lessons/activities.

What makes us a great school group destination:

- 4th – 12th grades – Choose between our digital tours or traditional guided tours, and consider adding on a classroom activity/lesson.
- Our museum is accessible for all - we're on one level, with curb cut access from our own parking lot.
- Large capacity restrooms are available in our entry lobby and within the museum to handle groups quickly.
- Our staff and volunteers are there for you during your entire visit, ready to share their knowledge!

Things to consider before you book:

- Do you have younger students? Our Tech Tales program for **PreK-3rd grade**, includes a read-aloud STEAM-based story and craft or activity. It lasts about 1-1.5 hours.
- One chaperone per 10 students is required.
- Chaperones will be required to stay with their group throughout the visit.
- Lunch space can be reserved. Meals must be brought in.

No refunds of deposits will be made for cancellations less than 30 days prior to the date of the scheduled visit. 7.75% tax will be applied unless exemption is requested. To receive state sales tax exemption, proof of State of Georgia Sales Tax Exemption (GA ST-5 form) must be presented at time of booking. Refunds can not be given for taxes already paid.
